Under this agreement for 2018

Alexandra Bay State School will receive

\$18,800*

This funding will be used to:

- ensure >80% of Prep to Year 6 students achieve a 'C' standard/'working with' result in English in 2018
- ensure every student on an Individual Curriculum Plan will achieve a 'C' standard or better against the determined year level achievement standard
- ensure the P-10 Literacy Continuum is used to monitor progress and plan for next steps in writing
- ensure every student will either:
 - meet the National Minimum Standard (NMS) in literacy and numeracy for their year level, or
 - have an evidence based intervention learning plan or an Individual Curriculum Plan (ICP) in place to address their specific learning needs.

Our initiatives include:

- **improving student outcomes in English through capability building all staff through the following:**
 - developing teachers' capability to embed feedback in the teaching and learning cycle
 - providing focused and intensive teaching for target students to attain at least a 'C' standard or higher in order to improve the quality of their demonstrations of learning
 - providing targeted professional development and coaching to deepen teachers' understanding of the Australian Curriculum and ensure teacher clarity of the literacy demands in English summative assessment tasks
 - developing coaching cycles with teachers using the co-plan, co-teach, co-reflect and co-assess framework from Lynn Sharratt
 - refining teachers' pedagogical practice with the Gradual Release of Responsibility and best research based practices
 - implementing weekly short term data cycles with analysis of student work samples to inform quality teaching and learning
 - providing support for students identified/targeted
 - building teacher capability in gathering and using evidence to determine the different year-level curriculum some students require and to develop and successfully implement challenging but achievable Individual Curriculum Plans (ICPs)
 - building capacity of teachers to implement the P-10 Literacy Continuum.
