This funding will be used to

- Ensure that by the end of 2022 >90% of students will receive a C standard or above in English.
- Ensure that > 80% of year 3 students will achieve National Minimum Standards in reading, spelling and writing in Naplan 2022.
- By the end of 2022 ensure 100% of staff achieve their goals from the Professional Development Plans aligned with the school's Annual Implementation Plan.
- Ensure >80% of students from Prep to Grade 6 can articulate their learning through the Four Guided Questions from the School Improvement Model.

Our initiatives include

- Ensure that all students with a disabilities or learning difficulties access intervention tailored to suit their needs.
- Ensure students can identify next steps for better English result through the use of Visible Learning Wall and Literacy Progressions.
- Ensuring that all teachers are building their knowledge, understanding and capabilities around delivering the Australian Curriculum with fidelity.
- Ensuring that all teaching staff build capability around moderation and assessment aligned with the Australian Curriculum using and adapting from the P-6 Curriculum Planning Model.
- Ensuring that all teacher aides build capabilities in intervention and phonemic awareness to support student needs.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Professional development for teachers and teacher aides to ensure student success in English, build knowledge, develop capabilities and support all students including with disabilities and learning difficulties.
- Cost 6,689 includes \$1,366 carried from 2021
- Human Resources Increase student support through targeted intervention and support for literacy development delivered by a teacher or teacher aide. Cost \$6,000.
